2009-10 SCHOOL YEAR ANNUAL FEES & TUITION SCHEDULE

REGISTRATION FEE:

\$100.00 per school year, per student
non refundable/required to reserve class space

CURRICULUM, BOOK USAGE, & SUPPLY FEE (covers initial supplies for each student):

PreK1 to PreK3	\$100 annually - \$50 due Sept 1 & \$50 due Jan 15
PreK4	\$200 annually - \$100 due Sept 1 & \$100 due Jan 15
Elementary	\$400.00 annually before school begins (\$200 due June 1st/\$200 due Aug 1st)

TUITION:

Infant to 17 mos.	\$170 weekly \$735 monthly
18 mos. to 23 mos.	\$150 weekly \$650 monthly
PreK 2 Class	\$140 weekly \$605 monthly
PreK 3 & 4 Class	\$130 weekly \$560 monthly
Kindergarten - 5 th Grade	\$5,600.00 annually (3% cash/check discount. Tuition is non-refundable) Ten Monthly Installments of \$560.00 due Aug 1 st or 15 th thru May 1 st or 15 th (parents: at beginning of school year please choose 1 st OR 15 th and this will be your due date) Field Trips, including transportation, will be billed separately 2-4 times per school year.
Extended Day Program	6:30a.m. to 6:30p.m. Monday through Friday <u>No additional fee for full-time CCA students.</u>
School Age Camps	Optional day camps are offered during holiday, spring break, and summer break. Reservations required in advance, please. \$110 per week or \$35.00 per day 'drop-in' rate. Field Trip Fees are included in weekly camp rates - "Drop ins" not accepted on field trips. Sack lunches & snacks are needed for all camps.

Frequently Needed School Information (refer to CCA Student Handbook for detailed CCA policies)

- ❖ CCA school tuition policies require that ALL student school tuition (Infants – 5th grade) must be paid consistently from the start of school in August to the end of May without interruption for planned or unplanned student absences. Please make note that tuition is always due during holiday periods regardless of your child's attendance. Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month/late after the 2nd OR if you choose to pay the 15th of each month/late after the 16th. Weekly tuition is due in advance each Monday and late if paid after Tuesday. CCA handbook details late fees. Because CCA relies solely on parent payments for school support, nonpayment of tuition may result in discontinuation of services.
- ❖ Elementary tuition (Kinder through 5th Grade) is an annual amount of \$5,600.00 for 2009-10. This can be paid in one non-refundable payment of \$5,600.00 minus a 3% cash/check discount OR CCA can divide this amount into 10 equal installments of \$560.00 to be paid in monthly installments from August 1st through May 1st or from August 15th through May 15th (parents can choose to pay consistently on either the 1st or the 15th of each month) This tuition includes private school tuition only and does not include holiday/spring break/summer camp. Please budget separately for holiday/spring break/summer camp.
- ❖ If a new student enrolls at CCA anytime during the school year his/her tuition will be pro-rated to begin at that point in the calendar year, and the regular tuition policies resume from that point forward.
- ❖ During summer period from June to August 14th, parents may pick and choose the weeks their student will attend and pay only for those weeks (all ages)!
- ❖ There is a 10% Sibling Discount off the lesser priced tuition unless other discounts apply.
- ❖ Uniforms are required for students in PreK3 through 5th grade during the school year from mid August to end of May. Every Friday is free dress day!
- ❖ CCA Field Trip shirts are \$10.00 per shirt. Elementary students have 2-4 field trips per year. School age camp has 1 field trip per week.
- ❖ PRESCHOOL FOOD PROGRAM: In 2009-10 CCA students Infant, PreK1, PreK2, PreK3 and PreK4 will be eligible to participate in a child care food reimbursement program regulated by the State of Texas. As such, a daily breakfast and lunch will be served. These meals will be catered from The Healthy Lunch Box. Any associated costs are included in tuition. All parents must complete a form annually for this program. Parents provide all snacks.
- ❖ ELEMENTARY FOOD PROGRAM: In 2009-10 CCA students Kindergarten through 5th grade will have an opportunity to pre-order daily lunches from The Healthy Lunch Box. Menu and order forms will be distributed monthly, and on-line ordering will soon be available as well. The cost will be \$2.50 per meal. A variety of menu options will now be offered daily to elementary students such as a hot lunch, hoagie lunch, baked potato/salad lunch, soup/sandwich or chef salad. This food must be ordered in advance through The Healthy Lunch Box. If your child does not order lunch on any given day, he/she must bring a lunch/beverage to school that does not require heating or refrigeration. Parents provide all snacks.
- ❖ All preschool students need to bring a travel size pillow and blanket for nap time. PreK4 (only) need kindermats.
- ❖ CCA accepts financial assistance from The Worksource as partial tuition payment if you are approved for assistance with this agency. An adjustment fee, in addition to your parent fee assigned by The Worksource, is due weekly. This fee varies person to person and can be quoted by our bookkeeper or administrator. Registration and curriculum/supply fees are never covered by The Worksource and are due as regularly scheduled.
